On behalf of their California Chapters, I am writing in support of AB 222 (Adams).

AB 222 would update the Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 to incorporate changes that will enable and expedite the production of advanced, non-food derived biofuels, green power and other biobased products from biomass. By providing a pathway for new investments in technologies to occur in California, and still retaining California's stringent environmental protections, AB 222 can allow California to lead the nation in the establishment of advanced technology facilities and provide additional resources for jurisdictions to meet SB 1016 disposal requirements.
